Call for entries for 20 participants (10 of which with scholarships) for the I level Master of Performing Arts organized by Azienda Speciale Palaexpo and Academy of Fine Arts of Rome.

Whereas:

- the annual First Level Master's Degree in Performing Arts (MAP_PA – Master in Arti Performative di Palaexpo e Accademia) is organised by Azienda Speciale Palaexpo and Academy of Fine Arts of Rome and will start in the second half of January 2022 and will end in September 2022;
- the Master is co-directed by Cecilia Casorati, Director of the Academy of Fine Arts of Rome and Cesare Pietroiusti, President of Azienda Speciale Palaexpo, and is curated by Ilaria Mancina, curator at Mattatoio-ASP;
- the Master has been approved at the meeting of the Academic Council of the Academy of Fine Arts of Rome of 27/03/2021 Minutes n. 15 prot. 9967 (22.04.2021);
- the aim of the Master is to offer a training course that, through the exploration of the languages of Theatre, Music, Dance and Visual Arts, can guide participants towards new forms of artistic experimentation and interdisciplinary research;
- the Master will be developed through a series of workshops to be led by artists, curators and national and international experts; numerous theoretical seminars will contribute to deepening the educational path in order to achieve a creative and critical vision;
- the Master is addressed to artists in the various disciplines of the performing arts, to curators and theorists of contemporary art, to researchers and scholars interested in exploring the possibility that the concept itself of "performing art" may expand towards experiences and practices not necessarily linked to the usual ways of considering and setting up exhibitions and live shows;
- the contaminations between languages and practices, the different ways of using spaces (theatres, museums, urban and natural spaces) and their relations with bodies, will be some of the core subjects of the Master in Performing Arts MAP_PA.

A comparative evaluation procedure is open for:

- the compilation of a list of candidates based on assessments of documents and interviews for the 10 merit scholarships of € 3,000 each, two of which will be offered by the Accademia di Belle Arti di Roma and eight by the Azienda Speciale Palaexpo;

- the compilation of a ranking list of candidates for the remaining 10 positions without a scholarship.

Candidates of any nationality who meet the following requirements may apply for this call for applications:

- Old system university degree, Bachelor Degree, Master Degree and/ or equivalent diploma or other qualification issued abroad, recognised as suitable according to the current regulations.
- Candidates of any nationality who have an ISEE* of less than € 50,000 per year may apply for one of the 10 scholarships.

*The Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE) is an indicator used to assess and compare the economic situation of households.

The ranking list of candidates will be compiled according to the following criteria:

- Curriculum Vitae assessment and proven artistic experiences, in particular in the performing arts and critical fields (up to a maximum of 30 points);
 - organisation skills, experiences of participation in forms of shared learning, activation and creative management of spaces (maximum of 10 points)
 - motivational interview (maximum 20 points);
- and, in addition, for scholarship applicants:
- ISEE (in the event of a tie evaluation, the candidate with the lowest ISEE will be chosen).

All applications for the one-year Master's Degree in Performing Arts MAP_PA must be received by 12 noon on 30 November 2021 at the following e-mail address mastermap_pa@abaroma.it accompanied by the following material:

- Application form (attached);
- Self-certification of education qualifications;
- Copy of an I.D. document;
- Curriculum Vitae updated to 2021 (max 2 pages);
- Portfolio updated to 2021 in pdf format containing links to web pages, photos and videos (max 8 pages 5mb);
- Declaration of good knowledge of Italian and English languages, both spoken and written;
- ISEE certificate issued by INPS (or equivalent document for non-Italians) for the application for the scholarship.

All documentation must be submitted in pdf format and sent by email to mastermap_pa@abaroma.it. If the requested material is not received by the deadline or is incomplete, the application will not be valid and will not be assessed.

The selection of suitable candidates and the awarding of scholarships will be based on the evaluation of the documentation submitted and on an interview, carried out by a Commission to be appointed by the Academic Board of the Accademia di Belle Arti di Roma in agreement with the Azienda Speciale Palaexpo.

The judgement of the Commission is unquestionable.

Any scholarship that will become available due to the renouncement of one of the selected candidates, will be awarded to the next eligible candidate.

Between 10th and 17th of December, eligible candidates will undergo an interview (online) with the Commission. The final list of candidates eligible for a scholarship (n.10 places) and for a position without a scholarship (n.10 places) will be published by 22nd of December 2021 on the website of the Accademia di Belle Arti di Roma (<http://www.abaroma.it>) and on the website of the Mattatoio-Azienda Speciale PalaExpo (www.mattatoioroma.it). Within 10 days from the date of publication of the list, the selected candidates must send – under penalty of exclusion - a declaration of acceptance, without reserve, of the scholarship to mastermap_pa@abaroma.it.

Participation in the Master has a cost of € 3.000,00, students who will be awarded the 10 scholarships offered by Azienda Speciale Palaexpo and Accademia di Belle Arti will be exempt from this cost; instead, they will have to pay the taxation costs (attendance fee € 76.67; enrolment fee € 30.26; stamp duty € 16.00; Lazio region tax for the right to study € 140.00). Students selected as eligible, but without a scholarship, must, in order to enroll, pay the above said taxes (attendance fee €76.67; enrolment fee €30.26; stamp duty €16.00; Lazio region tax for the right to study €140.00) and pay the first instalment of €1,500.00, corresponding to 50% of the total cost, by 10th of January 2022.

As a result of Art. 9 bis of Law Decree no. 52 of 22 April 2021, inserted by Law Decree no. 105 of 23/07/2021, participation in the activities is permitted exclusively to candidates with one of the COVID-19 green certifications.

The Master will take place in the spaces of the Pelanda, which depend from the Azienda Speciale Palaexpo, and in classrooms of the Academy of Fine Arts, both located in the area of the Mattatoio of Testaccio (Rome).

At the end of the course, a Level I Master's diploma will be awarded.
